I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your communication of 20th ultimo, with reference to letter received from the above noted man. I have investigated the case and find that he was attested in the Regiment on May 13th 1918 and discharged on the 29th of July, on the recommendation of the Travelling Medical Board.

The cause of his discharge was asthma, which as you will note from his letter he had had previous to enlisting. The Medical Board advise that this was not due to Military Service. He was accordingly struck off the strength as above noted. Authority: King's Regulations & Orders, Para. 392, Sub-Section (111) (c).


