Any information you may send me will be very gratefully received. I am enclosing the addresses of both boys, the ones I received last. The last hospital John was in, was I think the Fourth London Stationary Hospital. Thanking you in advance for your courtesy, and

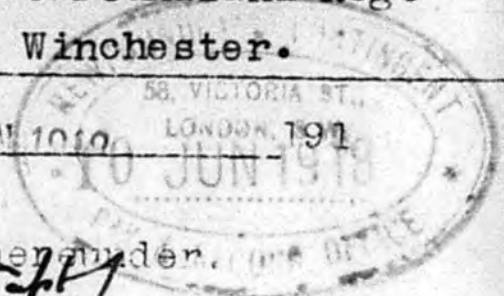
