was in a precarious state of health

for weeks previous broke down
completely when she heard of it, and
if I cannot get his discharge at once
I despair of her life.

I hope you will do your
utmost to help me, and if when my
wife regains her health, Richard is
of the same mind, I will offer no
objections to his going; but if he
continues in the Regiment at the
present time, I am afraid his
mother will not live to see the
end of this week.

Trusting you will use
your influence to have him discharged

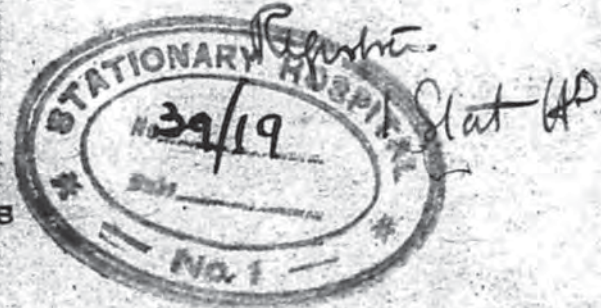
