It is noted that the Regimental Humber given in our notification to you was 3477, but I may say that this is purely a clerical error, and we are sorry that this should have occured. As to your son being a Prisoner in Germany, or being still alive, while not wishing to deprive you of any little hope you may have, I would say that I think there is very little doubt that it was your son \$3447 Ptc. Alfred Fiscock who was killed on March 14th 1918. As to your receiving any of his Personal Effects, I would say that in due course everything belonging to him that can be found, will be forwarded from the Record Office, Bondon, to St. John's, for delivery to you; but this will be some little time yet.

As I have already stated, I would advise you not to attach too much importance in this difference in Regimental Numbers, because undoubtedly it is due to error. However, in accordance with your request, we shall telegraph London for particulars of your son's death, and upon receipt of a reply, we shall again communicate with you.



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


