Information has been obtained from 3808 Corp. Ralph who was in the same Company as Pfe. Hobbs that he was quite close to the latter when he was wounded. Pte. Hobbs was struck in the side by two machine gun bullets about 3.30 p.m. on Oct. 20th during the advance of his company in the attack after the crossing of the LYS. Corp. Ralph states he was not killed outright, but that about five minutes later he was hit again by a sniper and when he left him Pte. Hobbs was dead. This is
