I have the honour to bring to your notice an application that has been received at this office from Pte. No. 237. A. J. Hogan formerly of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, for a refund of the sum of £28:10:5, which sum was deducted from his pension to cover cost of passage from St John's to Liverpool on or about 16th April last.

It appears that the above named was repatriated to Newfoundland on completion of his War Service and that he came of his own accord to this Country for treatment, and that he signed an undertaking to pay for his own passage.

From the Medical reports in your possession it will be seen that Pte Hogan has suffered the amputation of his right leg since coming to England, and he requests that consideration may be given to his application to have the above amount refunded.

In all the circumstances of this case I would ask that sympathetic consideration may be extended to Pte Hogan's application.
