I have the honour to invite your attention to the following claim in which I think I am fully justified.

On August 26th. 1916, I was granted a commission as Second Lieutenant in the Royal Mfld. Regiment. This was done to conform with the King's Regulations which called for a commissioned officer to complete discharges.

At that time I was drawing a salary made up as follows:-

For regimental work	\$1000.00 per year
For Mfld. Patriotic Fund	250.00
For Pensions	

and from January 1st. 1917 an additional \$250.00 for work in connection with pensions.

After the formation of the Militia Dept., I made a claim for the difference between these combined salaries and the amount payable for my rank, and this claim was allowed.

I have since come to the conclusion that in making this claim, I should not have included the allowances from the Patriotic Fund and Pensions Board, as the work in connection with these was over and above my regular regimental work.

I now submit for your attention, a claim for the difference, amounting to \$493.93.

At that time I was drawing a salary made up as follows:-

For regimental work	\$1000.00 per year
For Nfld. Patriotic Fund	250.00
For Pensions	

and from January 1st, 1917 an additional \$250.00 for work in connection with pensions.

After the formation of the Militia Dept., I made a claim for the difference between these combined salaries and the amount payable for my rank, and this claim was allowed.

I have since come to the conclusion that in making this claim, I should not have included the allowances from the Patriotic Fund and Pensions Board, as the work in connection with these was over and above my regular regimental work.

I now submit for your attention, a claim for the difference, amounting to \$493.93.

I have the honour to approach you on the following matter,

I have, this morning, received copy of Minute of the Honourable, the Executive Council in re increased clothing allowance for Royal Naval Reservists, with an intimation that payments are to be made by this department. Of course, I can have no objection to making the payments, or to carrying out the wishes and instructions of the Government in this respect; But I respectfully submit that there appears to be a tendency to saddle this Department with a great deal of extra work without making provision for the carrying out of same, or suitable remuneration for those who are called upon to fulfil the duties required.

I would respectfully remind you that last year, when we were instructed to pay the Augmentation Pay of Royal Naval Reservists, I approached you on the matter of an allowance for same, and I was given to understand that you would take the matter up. I presume that in the press of other important matters this has escaped your memory.

I would further respectfully point out, that I have no objection to the amount of the actual work that the various duties of the Department entail, but I think that if an officer is charged with duties other than those that come within the scope of the work required of his rank, and if he is capable of performing extra duties of the kind and of undertaking the responsibility of performing such duties effectively, he should receive remuneration for such extra services.

I feel, Sir, that with the onerous duties imposed upon me by the recent decisions of the Government covering the following matters, viz.,

War Service Gratuity
Increased Clothing Allowance (Regimental)
Retro-active Separation Allowance,
Second Augmentation of Pay of Royal Naval Reservists

it is unfair to expect me to assume other duties, without

making provision for remuneration.




