

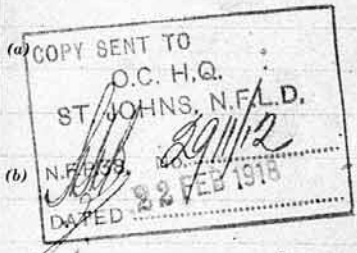

I have the honour to tender my resignation as Sergeant Instructor of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment to take effect Jan. 31/18. My reasons for taking this step are as follows.

On returning from the Funeral of the late Lord Bishop on Friday Jan. 11th. I was told by the Adjutant to take charge of the parade when nearing Headquarters. On reaching the Parade Grounds I gave work of Command which was interfered with by the Commanding Officer, who expressed himself in a very unusual manner used words uncalled for. This was heard by all ranks and I consider it a Breach of discipline in every respect.

During my three Years service as Sergeant Instructor such expressions as these have never been used towards me. I have always endeavored to preform my duties to the best of my ability and have tried to oblige my juniors as well as my seniors.

Trusting you will be able to make the necessary arrangements.

Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith letter received from Sergeant Instructor Hussey wherein he tenders his resignation from duty with the Regiment to take effect January 31st. 1918, giving as his reason for this step Para. 2 of his letter.

You will remember that when nearing the Armoury the parade was passed over to Hussey to lead into the building and dismiss, and I left just before they entered and proceeded to the Orderly Room. What happened after that I am unable to say, so beg to refer the matter to you for your attention.

I beg to submit for your consideration that the loss of Serg. Instructor Hussey will be a severe blow to the organization of and the carrying out of the syllabus of Recruit Training laid down by Capt. O'Grady, and now being carried out. He is the only man here who is thoroughly conversant with the work, having been connected with it ever since it was started, and as far as I can see there is no man to take his place and nobody in sight. The four Sergeants Instructors and Sergeant Winslow are not available and if they were could not do the work as owing to their training as Specialists they have lost touch with the usual Recruit drill etc. Sergeant Hennebury and Dooley are re-attested men, and neither suitable for the job and the man who could successfully attempt to carry out the work, Sergeant Edwards, is physically unfit.

The resignation of Hussey could not come at a more inopportune time, as with Capt. O'Grady away and a large N.C.O. class now

in training, and we are urgently in need of N.C.O's the work is bound to receive a serious set back.

Will you please advise me at your earliest convenience.





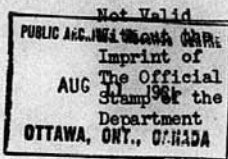
