Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability

The Soldier should be given a full opportunity of examining it, as, if awarded a pension, his subsequent identification depends on his confirming this declaration. 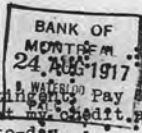

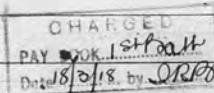
