

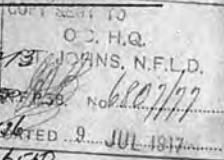

My dear Whitaker,-

In the Draft which was despatched on the 12th inst., there are returning several men who had been previously overseas and returned to Headquarters. Notably Kean, Scott and Ivany. It was a matter of some comment here when these men were returned, as there was nothing in the condition of their health that would seem to require repatriation, and they were not of the stamp of men whom it was considered that an officer would return for home defence work, their conduct sheets being anything but satisfactory. Under ordinary circumstances it might be considered good policy to discharge such men, but as they are physically fit, it would be nothing short of a crime to allow such men to get their discharge because of their own misconduct and general bad character. Their place is in the first line, and if they cannot conduct themselves properly they should be dealt with ~~according to~~ with regulations. The Minister of Militia has been none too well pleased at these men having been returned together with one or two others who have evaded the draft and I would suggest that there is nothing to be gained by your returning this type of man to Newfoundland unless he is considered permanently unfit for General Service.
