Dear Mr. Wood,

Upon looking up our records I find that we have but one "Henry James" Regimental number 3330 who was a member of the Windsor Draft. He has been discharged from the Regiment and he is now undergoing treatment in Jensen Camp. His parents reside at 15 Cook Street, St. John's. He was wounded on December 2nd G.S.W. Back, and entered the Third London General Hospital, Wandsworth on December 21st 1917. He returned to Newfoundland on August 5th 1918 and was discharged on September 2nd.

To avoid any mistake with regard to this man's identity I would suggest that you drop a line to Jensen Camp and ask him if he knows the people on behalf <sup>of whom</sup> you are making the inquiry.

Opinion of the Medical Board.

Notes.—(i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

(ii.) Expressions such as "may," "might," "probably," &c., should be avoided.

(iii.) *The rates of pension vary directly according to whether the disability is, (A) caused or aggravated by service in the present war, (B) due to causes not connected with present war, viz. 
