



In reference to Private Charles James 3983 I beg to say that this soldier is under an indenture to me to serve thirteen years from the 12 Sept. 1908 when he would be 21 years of age.

Last fall I allowed the young man to enlist as I felt it my duty but I certainly understood that I would get whatever money was due him. I am now told that he allotted his money to his mother under the name of Mr. Charles James. The mother re-married shortly after the boy was apprenticed to me and as I have reared him up I do not consider it fair for the mother to receive the money. I therefore protest against the payment and ask if it cannot be sent to me. I enclose herewith a letter that Charles sent my wife some time ago. Yours truly
