He had been retained at the Convalescent Hospital as he still required Massage until such time as the city Station for this purpose had been established, which Station was ready on Friday.

All men on the strength will, of course, be ordered to report to Headquarters when their discharge from the Convalescent Hospital is recommended.

There has been some difficulty in knowing just who are discharged and who are not discharged. Men recommended for the Convalescent Hospital whom the Officer i/c Records thought would be discharged after their treatment in Convalescent Hospital have, I understand, had their discharge proceeded with. 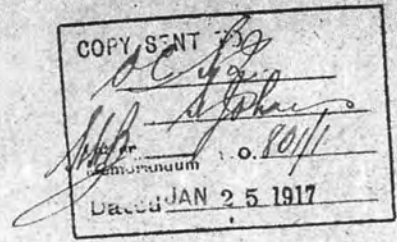
