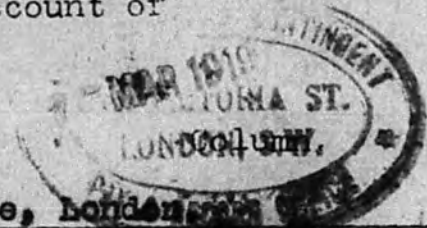

Dear Madam:-

Referring to your letter of March 17th, I regret to hear of the death of your son.

With regard to his funeral expenses and the providing of a headstone for his grave, I do not know of any Department of the Government which provides such. The whole matter of looking after the burial and the graves of deceased soldiers was dealt with by the Imperial War Graves Commission, London, England, and so far as I have knowledge of their methods of procedure, I am quite sure that your application would not be considered by them, for the reason that they were only authorized to deal with cases of soldiers who died as a result of their service with the forces, and within a few years of the close of the war.

I am sorry that I cannot see any way to assist you in the matter.
