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

It is my painful duty to inform you that a report has been received from the War Office, notifying the fatality which has overtaken No. 803, Pte. W. Keane, which has been conveyed to you by telegram in accordance with custom; and I am to express the deep sympathy and regret of the Newfoundland Government at your irreparable loss.

The only particulars which are at present available state that he died as a result of gunshot wound in the back, at the 38th Casualty Clearing Station, France, on October 16th.

If articles or personal property of the late Private Keane are found they will be forwarded to this office, but some time may probably elapse before their receipt, and will naturally be subject to customary formalities concerning effects.

Application regarding the disposal of personal effects, or of any amount that may eventually be found due to the late soldier's Estate, should be addressed to this office.

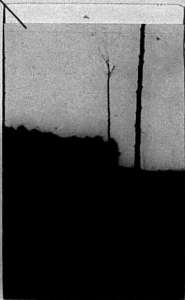

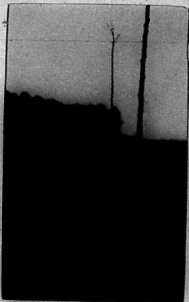
