"I am advised to write you concerning my account. I left Liverpool on May 23rd by the "Gorsican" and am demobilised. The Militia Department here tells me that I am paid in full, but I have had no statement and in my calculation I should have drawn at least \$10.00 more. There was some ration money due for my leave from April 28th till May 22nd of this year which may have been overlooked. Please let me have a statement at your earliest convenience.

As all pay letters and documents relating to the accounts of Officers and Other Ranks, who have been repatriated to Newfoundland up to day, have now been packed for shipment, we are unable to verify whether ration allowance for the period 28/4/19 - 21/5/19 was credited in his account prior to Embarkation. This question may be cleared up on arrival of the Pay Books and documents per s.s. "Digby", please.



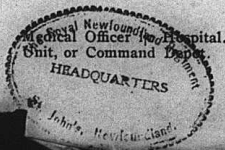
