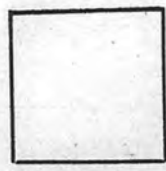

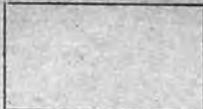



The cost of passage will in all cases be paid ^{by this Office} ~~DIRECT~~ to the Shipping Company concerned, and will not exceed the rates in force at the time of your discharge.

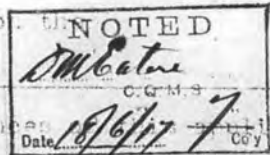

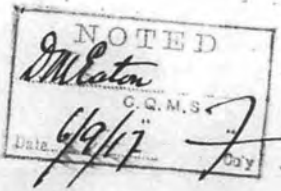

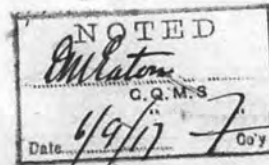
