

Reference 2002 L/C. A. Lawrence, whose discharge is approved for 8-5-19 and about whose pay I wrote you today, he states that only \$35.00 was paid him as Clothing Allowance on the ground that when he was previously discharged he was paid \$25.00.

As far as the Depot is concerned, we have been paying all Re-attested men on discharge the full \$60.00 allowance, and for that reason L/C. Lawrence's papers were marked as \$60.00 payable.


