

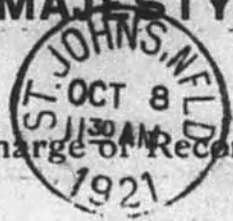

Then if you feel fit at the end of that period and the Medical Board is willing, you can be reattested for Depot duty.

You will, therefore, report to Orderly Room first opportunity, so that the necessary arrangements for your discharge may be carried out.




