

Dear Sirs,

I am writing upon the subject of my passage to and from St Johns. for the Memorial Day ^{services} of July 3rd. and the unveiling of the Sergeants Memorial,

I as an ex-sergeant was asked if possible to attend for that time and was given to understand by the G. W. V. A. that my fare was paid for me, so Sirs I left my work and attended, thinking it would only mean my lost of time, but I paid my fare both ways after trying to find out if the agents could not give me my fare, but they had no orders up to that time, so I am sending you my receipts to see if you will kindly do all you can for me, I have written to the G. W. V. A. and they seem only to ignore it, but Sirs after bearing four years in that terrible war, and now being asked to attend the Services of July 3rd. and told my only expense would be lost of time (which I could not afford to lose those times) I think it altogether unfair for me to be treated so,
