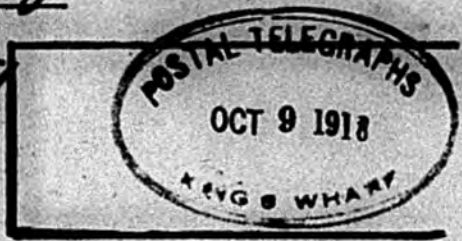

I spoke to Major Montgomerie about this man to-day, and he asked me to write following facts;- He is one of three brothers, the other two being married, with families; he lives at home with his father, who is sixty-eight years old, and his mother; he and his father have been fishing at Trap and latter would fish with trawls, one man cannot do this work alone, and there are no men about who can be employed, consequently, the father will be forced to give up the fishery altogether, unless the son can be spared to him for some time longer.

Major Montgomerie has promised to bring the matter before the Military Service Board for consideration, and I shall be obliged if you will forward this letter, with a request that leave of absence for this month in any case, and longer if possible, may be granted to the bearer.
