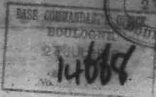

With reference to your enquiry concerning the above mentioned soldier, as to whether he is entitled to Post Discharge Pay and Clothing Allowance, I would state, for your information, that although the wound which caused the discharge of this soldier is stated by the D.A.A.G., Ind. Army to be negligently self inflicted, it is considered by the competent Military Authorities in France that he cannot be brought before a Field General Court Martial owing to lack of evidence. There is, therefore, no entry of conviction on his Conduct Sheet, and in accordance with Military Law he must be considered "not guilty".

Under these circumstances Post Discharge Pay and Clothing Allowance must be paid him.



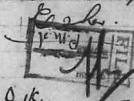

With reference to your enquiry concerning the above mentioned soldier, as to whether he is entitled to Post Discharge Pay and Clothing Allowance, I would state, for your information, that although the wound which caused the discharge of this soldier is stated by the D.A.A.G., 2nd. Army to be negligently self inflicted, it is considered by the competent Military Authorities in France that he cannot be brought before a Field General Court Martial owing to Lack of evidence. There is, therefore, no entry of conviction on his Conduct Sheet, and in accordance with Military Law he must be considered "not guilty"

Under these circumstances Post Discharge Pay and Clothing Allowance must be paid him.

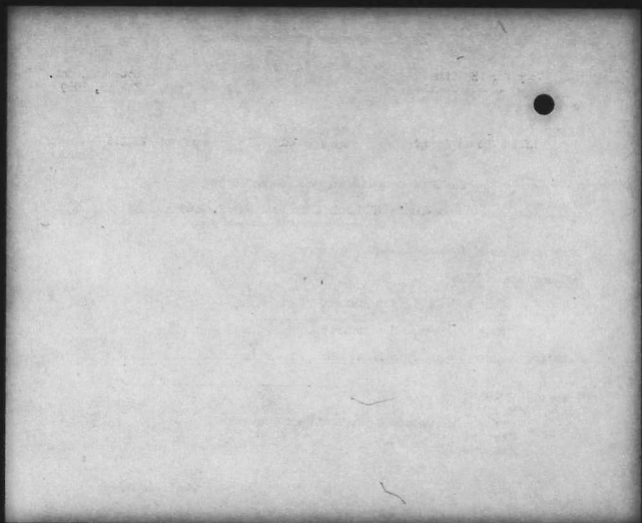
