it is ordered that any person who is or has been a member of
His Majesty's Forces during the present War and who has suffered

the effects of said disease may, on the certificate of the Medical
or Acting Medical Health Officer setting forth the nature of the
disease and recommending aggregation be arrested by any Peace
Officer and placed in the Military Hospital at St. John's and
there detained until pronounced cured by the Medical or Acting
Medical Health Officer or the Medical Superintendent of the
physician in charge of the said Hospital.

Any person so detained who escapes or who refuses to comply
with the rules and regulations of said Hospital, or any person
who aids another in escaping from said Hospital, shall be guilty
of a breach of this Order and liable on summary conviction to a
fine of One thousand Dollars and in default of payment to one year's

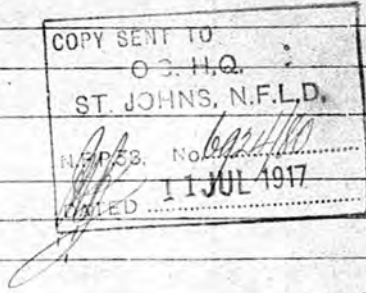
