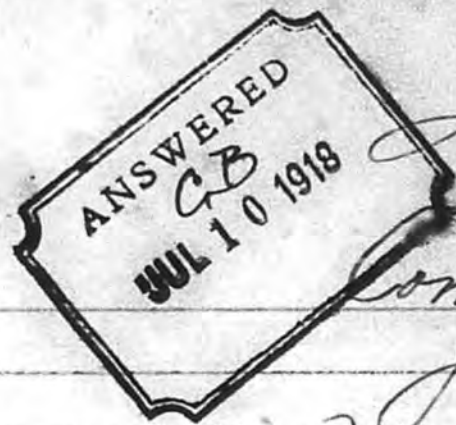
Dear Madam:

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 8th inst., having reference to your son, #5590 Pte. Michael Mansfield, The Royal Newfoundland Regiment, who was reported Missing on April 15th last. We have no further report of your son since he was posted as Missing, but I can assure you that immediately upon receipt of any information, whatever, concerning him, you will be immediately communicated with.

In answer to your query as to the possibility of your boy turning up as a Prisoner of War, I may say that the fact of three months having passed without any report of him, leaves little, if any, hope of him being a Prisoner in Germany.


