Would you kindly look up the papers of the Court of Enquiry on Sergt. Stanley T. Marks who was reported as a deserter in February 1915, anowho according to rumour

was a Germany spy.
I am investigating this matter through the Chief Constable at Ramsgate and the Secret Service at Scotland Yard. From the former I have received the following:

"I beg to report for the in"formation of the Chief Constable the "Stratheden" June 11th. 1915 "specting the marginally named "man (Stanley T. Marks). "interviewed his mother who is a "very respectable woman and re-"sides at 8 Arklow Terrace, East "Cliff. She informed me that "her son Stanley enlisted in the "Newfoundland Regiment in August "1914 and when on leave came to see her about November of the "same year and remained for "about 7 days. He then went awa "and she has never seen or heard "of him since and is very anxious "to know the whereabouts of her "son.
