On July 18<sup>th</sup>, the Ex soldier accosted me on the street, being without money and seeking help. After seeing his discharge papers and genuineness of his appeal I took him to the Salvation Army Hostel, Norton St., L'pool. and arranged he should be given bed and food over the week-end, since the Soldiers Relief Offices were then closed until the 21<sup>st</sup> (over Place Day). I also advanced Martin some cash.

On the 21<sup>st</sup> I went in person to the Discharged Soldiers Relief Assoc. Balch St., L'pool and arranged that he should get aid - a grant of £1. was given him immediately, but Martin failed to pay this in to the S.A.

Martin left the Hostel on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, stating

he had received his monthly instalment of gratuity and would return to pay on cashing it — but failed to reappear.

He left a debt of £4/11, as per bill of the Salv. Army enclosed, which the Manager has been compelled to hold me responsible for.

Can anything be done to make this a lien on the next payment of gratuity due Martin, or the matter be brought to his attention?

The S. A. advises me owing to lack of funds it is not possible to suffer this loss.

I shall appreciate your advice in this matter — it would seem a pity to have his man get into trouble.
