About the first of December you stated that parcels and letters which you were sending to your son #1401 Pte. J. McCarthy were not being received by him.



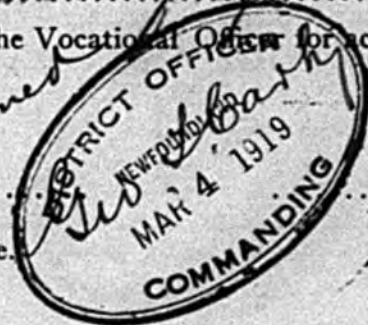

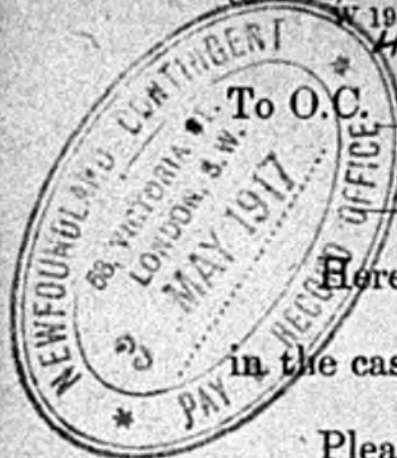
