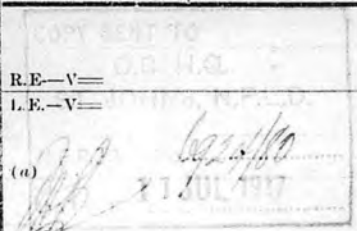

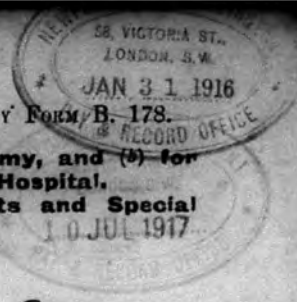



As you undoubtedly know Staff Rates of Pay have at last been introduced in the Department, which is a considerable increase on the ordinary rates, and in doing so there has been a difference made so conspicuous that we are obliged to call your attention to the matter, and submit the grievance imploring your kind consideration,

There is a number of us here, known as orderlies, working in connection with the department under CPL. Hawke. Our duty to the Department is to see at all times that all deceased soldiers effects, messages, Cheques, and correspondence of any kind are probably mailed or delivered as the case may be, and to make ourselves generally useful around the office. Some of the orderlies have been taken from the Corp's Squad and given duties inside, around the office. The increased rates have been given them and we are obliged to go on as usual,

Now Sir, we consider here, an injustice has been done, which we feel you will see adjusted when properly brought to your notice, we feel no distinction should have been made but rather all should be treated alike.

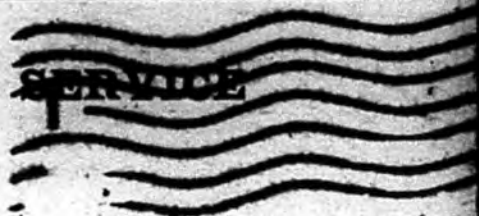
