Sir,

On arrival from South Africa a few days ago, I was surprised to see my name in your list in an old newspaper, and now take the pleasure of giving you the details of my being lost.

I left for S. A. a long time ago, and, a few months ago, a registered package came for me, to Mr. Lamb.

Mr. & Mrs. Lamb were in St. Johns on a vacation at that time, so the package was returned to the Gpt. of Militia.

I should have returned months ago, but had a great deal of trouble with my leg.

When I was wounded, my right tibia was splintered, and several pieces of bone were removed in London and Rep., but it seems there are still a few left.

The leg became inflamed & swollen, so I had to seek medical aid, with the result that my stay in Africa was lengthened very considerably.

In my way home, I removed one splinter of bone myself, and have had to give up my duties for the present owing to my

ankle being somewhat weak.

I expect to remain here for some time
now, and would be pleased to receive any
communications while here.



Sir:

In reference to our conference this morning, we beg to state our case plainly in writing.

On June 7th 1918 we were sent to Nr 2 O.C.B. Cambridge to train as Officers, we passed all War Office Examinations, and, on Nov. 30th we were fully qualified to hold Commissioned Rank in the Regiment.

We were kept on at Cambridge pending instructions from the P & R Office. About Dec. 10th Capt Emerson was sent to Cambridge to interview all Cadets, and to give them the option of going back to the Battalion at their former ranks or remaining as Cadets until Demobilization. This placed us on the same basis as Cadets who had just started their course, and, considering we had passed all Examinations and become fully qualified to hold commissioned rank we think it very unfair that such should be the case.

On December 17th there were no further instructions from the P & R. Office, so we were sent on leave until January 3rd.

On the expiration of this leave we found instructions for us to report to the P & R. Office by noon Jan. 6th on doing so we were told by Colonel Barton, D.S.O. O.C. Depot that we were entitled to the rank of 2nd Lieutenant and he ordered us to wear the badges of that rank. We were again sent on leave until Jan. 21st which was the date the transport was to sail from Liverpool. During this time we had to keep up the dignity and appearance of Officers on our former ranks pay.

On reporting to the 2nd Battalion Jan. 21st we were put on duty in the Orderly Room doing Officers work and we continued doing so until we reached ST. JOHN'S.

All the Colonial Cadets who were with us on the Course received their Commissions with pay and full allowance dating from Nov. 30th.

The Imperial Cadets were demobilized and started in their civilian Employment immediately. We feel quite justified in asking if you would kindly have our commissions dated from Dec 1st or, if that is impossible, we think we should be paid as 2/Lts. from the time we were ordered to wear the badges of that rank, Viz: Jan. 7th.
