Dear Sir:-

Few days ago friend ours and ex Ptes of 11th Regt called see me. In conversation with him he related story which causes me to write you.

A few weeks ago a chum of his (also ex Pte) was inquiring of him how much money his parents had recd while he was on active service etc. When their talk had ended my friend finds out that his parents had not recd their Separation allowances. Which they should have got. As his chum goes on to tell him it was same case with his parents, but he had succeeded after much writing etc in getting a cheque for \$600. only short while ago.

My friend also tells me he has written see if he can get his share, but up to then had no reply. Now I want you to give me more particulars, as I feel I am entitled to same. I give my case for your consideration.

My son enlisted, went over seas, was wounded just few days before Armistic. He came back, and up to couple months ago he barely could earn enough to keep himself. He is away now, in Canada. I guess it will be very little help he will be able give me. And I am unable earn anything myself. So its been with me for past year.

Kindly let me know as soon as possible what can be done and if its possible for me to get any of this Separation allowances. I shall ask you to reply to me and in meantime I will write my son this same story. I have heard since that several people Got this last year. My sons name and number enclosed.

Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter of November 20th., I beg to advise that Separation Allowance is only payable in cases where the father is living, if the said father was during the period of his son's service, absolutely incapable of earning, and if the son who was serving can be clearly shown to have been his only support at that time. In no other case can the allowance be granted when the father is living.

I gather from your letter that your son is not now able to help you, and further that you yourself are unable to earn anything. It is quite clear then that you must have some other means of support; but you do not state in your letter what this other support is.

Further you state that you have been unable to earn anything during the past year. The natural conclusion is that previous to one year ago you were earning or capable of earning, and as previously stated, if such is the case, the allowance will not be granted to you.

The simplest way to explain what the allowance really is, is to state that when the Army took away from a family its only means of support, they made an allowance to take the place of his help, while they had the use of his service, and when they restored him to his family, the allowance ceased, and if the case warranted payment for disability, pension was granted to the soldier.

I should judge from your letter that your claim for the allowance cannot be satisfactorily proved, and consequently it seems useless to send an application form. If, however, you still think that the allowance is due you, I shall be pleased to forward you the regular form of application.

Please note, however, that the fact that other people have received the allowance does not entitle you to it. Their cases may appear to be similar to yours, but you may be assured that if their claims do not fulfil the requirements of the regulations, they
