I am in receipt of your latter of June 15th, forwarding letter from Mr. Allen Moores, brother of No. 3250 Pts. John Moores, descaped,

In reply to the questions raised by Mr. Moores, I would state that the pay accounts of his brother have been handled in secondance with regulations and the practice that her obtained in this Department all through, Private Moores was killed on 5th October, 1918, and automatically his pay seased at the end of that month. As the allotment referred to by Mr. Moores is the assignment of his pay made by Private Moores to his sister, Miss Alice May Moores, that of course ceased at the end of October, 1918. Allotments were communicat the request of the Pensions Board when it was payable to a parent and until such time as the Pensions Board decided on a claim for pension on account of a deceased soldier. War Service Cretuity is not payable on account of a decemed soldier: and a pegaien is payable only where it is shown that a person was mainly dependent on that sold lar,
