Dear Sir:-

I am in receipt of a letter from Major Parsons of the Pension Board, sent at the instance of His Excellency the Governor regarding the funeral expenses of one of my soldier sons who died at Pilley's Island in 1918. He also refers to the possibility of a pension and encloses forms to be filled out. As I am sixty-nine years of age and past very active labor I should like to ask for consideration for the following reasons. I had five sons serving in the Nfld and American army and navy. My son #1969 Pte. Lemuel Morey died at Pilley's Island on June 23rd. 1918. I understand that he did not receive his discharge pay or gratuity. If that is so I feel sure that you will admit the claim I ~~make~~ ^{make}, and to all monies that would have come to him. I shall be glad to hear from you regarding the matter. I received support from my son before he passed away, and feel that any help that may have accrued from his services might justly come to me.

Dear Captain Hamilton,

In answer to your note of the 20th inst., with reference to the enquiry of Mr. J.T. Morey, of Butts Harbour, as to whether he will be reimbursed for the expenses incurred in connection with the burial of his son, #1967 Pte. Morey, who died in hospital at Pilley's Island, I beg to advise you that as Pte. Morey was discharged prior to his entering hospital for treatment, his case comes directly under the Board of Pension Commissioners. I have taken the matter up with the latter, and there seems to be no doubt about Mr. Morey being entitled to a refund of the amount of his expenditure on this account.

The Board of Pension Commissioners will communicate direct with Mr. Morry.

Have sent one Joseph Francis in jointmentment by Dogteam and Reed Newfoundland, after preliminary examination here.

Do grant me permission to open an active recruiting station here or will I wait further developments?

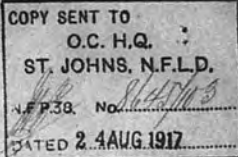


