Re Explanation and Authority for Letter of 15. Inst

With reference to the above, I regret that I can only give verbal authority as I received it.

During last month you wrote to the C.O. applying for extra rate of pay, as daid down in Canadian Rules and Regulations. During the consideration of this matter I made an enquiry to the Adjutant, and asked him if any think was to be done in the matter. The following is what he told me.

The O.C. of the Denot brought your matter before the D.O.C.

The O.C. of the Depot brought your matter before the D.O.C. who said that owing to an N.C.O. being paid as ordely room clerk it would be impossible for you to draw it also, yet he recommended that if the work was too much for one man, that another could be put in to assist in the work. Now as the Adjutant is away I am unable to give any further authority or explanation.

I have the honour to apply through you to the Commanding Officer for removal from my present duties to that of some other post.

When I returned from home leave, my instructions were to report to the District Officer Commanding, who ordered me to present myself before the Adjutant of the Depot for further orders. On doing so I was informed that my duties would consist of looking after the Pay Robls, I reported for said Buties on October 9th. 1917., but on later date I appeared on Daily Orders Part 11 No. 164. as Ordely Room Clerk, and was paid as such up to and including October 31st. when the Payment ceased. While under extra pay I considered it my duty to return at night in order to have the work both complete and accurate. At the order of the D.O.C. I was reduced to a privates rate of pay, I think it very unjust to expect the same amount of work done for ordinary pay, and same did not induce me to keep up the interest which was previously given to my duties.

I understand that when this matter was brought before the D.O.C. he reccommended that some other party be put in here to assist me. This however not being done he gave authority for my promotion to my present rank, and as I find it impossible to complete my duties with the necessary concord, which is required for one doing my work, I reques t that I be transferred to some other post.

If however you think it necessary for me to hold a lower rank while attached here, I would be quite willing to forfiet my Corporal stripes which were confirmed on me in Orders Part 11 of the 8th. inst.

Latest medical report indicates that he has quite recovered from his disability, and I think it would be quite in order that his application be sent forward to the Flying Corps, but they should be notified for what disability he was discharged from our Regiment, and its subsequent course.






