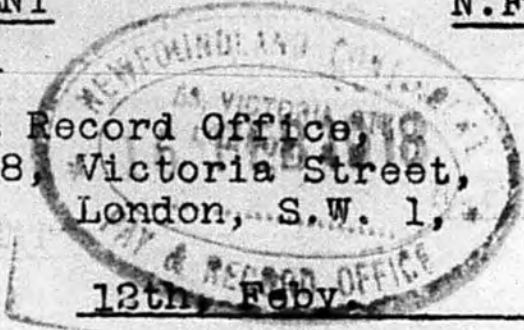

Of the men on Parade there was no one who wished to come into Barracks and so their names were struck off the Billeting List.

Neither Pte. Moore nor Pte. Murphy consequently is entitled to Board money after the 17th January.

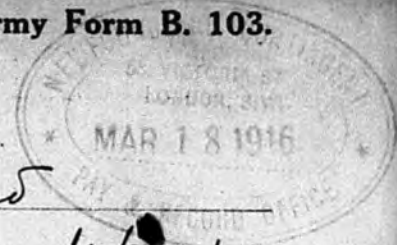
