The above noted is claiming pension because of enlarged glands in the neck. He was discharged A.I. in Feb./19 after serving 939 days. He was in Hospital in Jan/18 for 37 days and had a Thyroglossal cyst removed-from-his.

The Canadian regulations limit for claim, for enlarged gland after discharge, is six months. In this case claim is not made until nearly three years, a longer period than applicants service.

It is regretted that claim cannot be considered for pension at this late date.
