

Dear Sir.

It was with the greatest regret that the Government received a message from the Record Office, London, intimating that your son, Private John Myrick, had died on the 10th of December of diphtheria. Permit me to express, on behalf of the Government as well as for myself, the sincerest sympathy with you in this time of sorrow.

Your gallant led certainly did his best, and he was emongst the first who so bravely responded to the call of King and Country. He has done his duty nobly and bore his part like a man, and we are proud to have such brave young fellows who so loyally responded to the call and enlisted in the fight for the establishment upon this earth of the principles of Righteousness. Truth and Liberty -- principles which are most vital and most dear to us all. Your boy never flinched, and, though he has now laid down his earthly weapons, he wears instead the soldier's crown of victory. The Government are also proud that we have such unselfish and noble parents who so willingly gave their boys when the call of duty came, and it will be, no doubt, comfort to you to think that he did his bit, " and that his name will be inscribed upon the glorious Roll of Honour and held in fragrent memory by all his fellow countrymen.

May the comfort of the Great Father be given to you and yours at this time.
