London Gazette, 6th January 1917

Action Date, 12th October 1916 – Gueudecourt

For bravery in the field. On the 12th October near Gueudecourt he displayed the greatest courage in an attack on German trenches leading his men with great gallantry. On entering the hostile trench he led a bombing squad and cleared out the hostile bombing party. His courageous action cleared the trench and connected up with another company.
