With regard to Ex. No. 2066 Pte. R. Heville, following from the High Commissioner is quoted:-10th January 1920.

"Dear Sir: the reservation made from this Office in the name of Mr. William Lawrence per S.S. "Sachem" due to sail on or about the 15th inst "to St. John's, Newfoundland.
"In place of the above, kindly reserve passage for Ex. Pte. No. 2066 R. Neville of 3, Guthrie Street Edimburgh, by the same steamer. From the information at my "disposal it is not quite clear if the above-named ex. soldier is entitled to free transportation to Mewfoundland, but if it should happen that he has not been repatriated before, then I think an extension of the regulation period - namely six months should be granted as otherwise this man is likely to involve the Hewroundland Government im considerable expense. Unless, therefore, there are any special circumstances other than the expiration of the period of six months since his demobilisation in which Neville is ineligible for repatriation.

Please could you in any way help me get back my child that is in Scotland and wanted to get home with the last draft but they refused to take him. 2066 Pte. Ronald Weville. He is joined three years and a half. He has been wounded three times and five times in hospital altogether. He fought and fell for his King and Country -almost 4 years joined up now. He was 16 and 10 months when he joined. He was 20 his last birthday, a child still not out of my care. He is all I got - my only support. I got an invalid daughter aged 50. I am going up for 70 myself, so I don't think it is dealing him fair when all the rest of our boys she brought back to their old parents to leave him behind when he wants to get home with the rest. Being a child and with no education at all he never knew the mistake he was making by getting dis-'charged over there. He was so lone in the Regiment and getting tired of it as he was not needed any longer, and not feeling a bit well or strong, he thought he would take his discharge and go to Scotland. I think he was married there last year while on leave and stated with friends, when the big draft was coming he would come with them, but when he suplied to get home they would not take him.

What I am going to do without him I do not know.

There is snother draft coming now the last one, and if you could help him get slong this time you would have the best wishes of a broken hearted father and sister.




