

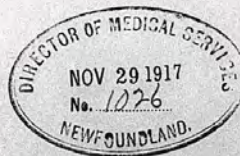

This man was before a Medical Board on May 4th 1920 and awarded a pensionable disability of 15%. In view of their findings it was agreed by the Board of Pension Commissioners that he would receive the sum of \$7.50 per month for a period of twelve months.

Dear Mr. Squires:-

When the question of the salary of the Messenger came up the other day you asked me if he received a pension as an ex soldier and I replied that he did. I was not at the time aware that during the past year the pension had been considerably reduced.

When ex-Private Edward Norris (NO. 1026 Royal Newfoundland Regiment) came to the Bank two years ago he was in receipt of a pension of \$32.00 per month. I may mention that he served through the Gallipoli campaign and was afterward invalided home suffering from dysentery.

The pension was subsequently raised to \$40.00 per month, then reduced to the former figure of \$32.00 and afterwards fell to \$20.00 and \$12.00. He now receives only \$7.50 per month although he is still subject to periodical attacks of dysentery, and he cannot understand why the amount has been so greatly reduced

He is a conscientious man, a good messenger, and a faithful servant generally. We would be very sorry to lose him, but I am afraid that we cannot expect to keep him unless he gets a further increase of military pension or salary

Will you be good enough to have his case enquired into by the Militia Department
