Enclosed please find a letter sent to me by Mr. S. Roberts, J.P., of Change Islands.

The man, John Oake, referred to in the letter met with a serious accident last week at Change Islands. The S.S. "CABOT", which was in the vicinity of Change Islands at the time, was requisitioned to take Mr. Oake to Lewisporte to connect with the train for the Hospital. It was thought by the Doctor at Change Islands at the time that the only chance of saving the man's life was to get him to the Hospital for treatment. Mr. Oake reached the Hospital last Saturday and, I understand, is doing nicely, but I am not in a position to say how serious his case is, or whether his condition is of such a nature that he will not in future be able to assume his former occupation and, consequently, be incapacitated, so that his earning power will be lessened to such an extent that himself and his large family will become dependent on charity to eke out an existence.

His son, Fred, who recently enlisted is the only support of a large family and, as the letter shows, his mother is asking that Fred be released from service in H.M. Forces.

I am sure you will appreciate the circumstances and grant the Mother's request, believing it is in the best interests of the Country and the Empire for Fred to stay at home and take his father's place in helping to support his parents and brothers and sisters.
