I beg to quote hereunder the details of the deed for which the Military Medal was awarded your ^{late} son #3603, Pte. Ed. O'Brien, Royal Newfoundland Regiment, taken from supplement to the London Gazette.

"For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty.
"On the morning of the 14th October 1918 during the advance from LEDEGHEM towards the LYS, almost before the barrage lifted, these two men dashed forward at a pill box. A few of the enemy were leaving the pill box, and as soon as they saw Ptes. O'Brien and Trask threw bombs at them, but these two men rushed in and bayoneted three of the enemy. They then went to the pill box and threw a bomb into it, then entered it, and captured an Officer and 25 men and 2 M.Gs. It was entirely due to the prompt action and dash of these two men that the enemy were prevented from bringing their M.Gs into action and causing heavy casualties."

Please accept my congratulations and assurance of the appreciation of the splendid conduct of your son.

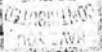
