



The United States Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service, has asked me to furnish proof of my having been honorably discharged from the Newfoundland Army at the close of World War I.

It is very important that I furnish the Department the proof that they ask for because it has an important bearing on my continuing as a resident of the United States.

I was born in St. Johns, Newfoundland and am the son of John Day, who lived at 6 York Street.

In 1916 I went overseas with the Newfoundland Army. As I recall it, my regimental number was #2172. I served in Company H under the name of Frederick George O'Day.

It is very important to me that I receive copies of my discharge papers, which will show that I was honorably discharged from the Newfoundland Army, because I have no status in this country at the present time. In order to continue to reside here and continue to assume the responsibility for the welfare of my daughter and her two children because my son-in-law is now serving in the U.S. Army, I am in urgent need of these papers.
