"D" I was No. 1 on the Machine Gun, the Corporal, and No. 2 was killed, I stayed by my gun until wounded, I then retired to the dugout, Germans captured me and six others, before I had time to get my wound dressed, the stretcher bearers had it half bandaged, but the enemy would not give them time to finish dressing it.

"E" I was taken to Oldam Camp, where I was kept for three months, I was unable to do any work on account of my wound, I was taken from there to a village named Weik, where I was sent to work on a railroad, I was treated very badly, I had to go from one to two days without food on several occasions and was forced to work very hard, I spent four months at this work. I was taken from there to a village near Bergen, where I was sent to work on a farm, I was kept there for two months; I was then taken to Oldam Camps again, where I was kept until I was sent to England after the Armistice was signed.

I do hereby truly affirm that the above is a true statement of my detention as a prisoner of war in Germany,

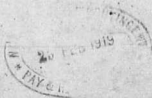
