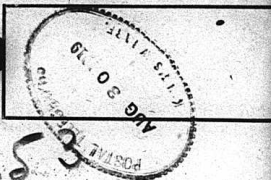

Dear Sir:-

I confirm my telegram of this date as follows:-

"Your letter February 10th just received
"all statements incorrect. This for your
"information in event of necessity of action
"pending receipt of my letter which follows."

The records of this Department show that No. 3653 Edmund Park enlisted on the 30th April, 1917; he gave his age as 19 years. He embarked for England on 19th May 1917, and proceeded for France on 23rd April, 1918. After the cessation of hostilities he was sent to England on 19th January, 1919, and was repatriated to Newfoundland on 30th January, 1919 and discharged on 10th April, 1919.

He was not wounded on service; and was not in hospital for any cause while in the Regiment. His service of over one year and under two entitled him to four payments of \$70.00 each as War Service Gratuity. On his return to this country he had a debit balance with the London Office of \$145; he was paid three cheques of \$70.00 each and one of \$28.55 which squared his account for \$280.00. On his enlistment he stated that he was unmarried, and gave as his next of kin his father, Mr. Reuben Park of Moivers Cove, St. Georges.

There is no balance at his credit in this Department at the present time, and he is not entitled to a pension. It would appear that his statements are entirely incorrect. My cable of this date was put you wise in case you wish to take any action in the meantime.
