I have heard that the remainder of the staff of the Militia Dept. who have been compelled to wear civilian clothes have received a sum of money to the amount of \$ 18.50 for the wear and tear of such clothes, whilst working there.

This letter is not intended to be in any ^{way} a complaint, as I feel that I was always treated by those in authority with justice, in accordance with the military laws of the different establishments to which I was attached. But I am submitting my case to you to enable you to judge whether I am entitled to the money referred.

In June 1918 I was attached to the London P. & Record staff, and like all other clerks of that establishment, supplied my own uniform. In September 1919 I came home and was attached to the Militia Dept. where I worked until May 9th this year, having then received my demobilization leave of 28 days. During the time I was there I wore uniform until it was the worse for wear, and had to discard it about the middle of March. From then I was compelled to wear civilian clothes, as uniforms could not be obtained.

I now ask you to kindly give this your best consideration and hoping to receive a favourable reply in the very near future.

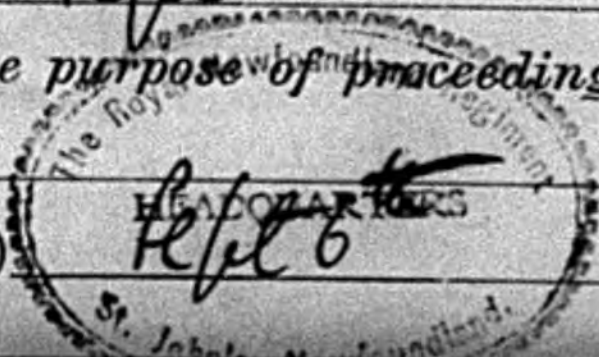
