For gallantry in the field. In the attack on the enemy near Langemarck on 16th August, 1917, he showed great skill and coolness in laying a tape in front of our positions just before the attack, for the Battalion to form up on, which was of the greatest assistance. He then led his company with conspicuous coolness and judgment and captured his objective, killing many of the enemy and capturing a machine gun.

Bar to Military Cross

London Gazette, 8/1/18 – Cambrai

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty at Masnières on 20th November 1917, in leading an attack and capturing a Canal Bridge under heavy fire. When the attack was disorganized by heavy fire after crossing the bridge, he showed the greatest energy and determination in reorganizing his men and continuing the advance.
