Statements made concerning an explosion which happened in the billet used by Battalion H'Qrs. runners. Ludansques, France 12/1/18.

1. Statement made by 2827 Pte. A. Vatcher.

At Ludansques, France, on January 12- 1918, at about 4.20 p.m., I was in the Billet used by the Battalion H. Qrs. runners. We had just come off the ceremonial parade and were sat around the fire place eating tea. I was sat in front of the fire place, Corpl. Dunn was sat on my right. Pte. Payne was on my left. Pte. Chaffey picked up a piece of heavy wrapping paper from the floor and placed it on the fire. Shortly after he placed it on the fire there was an explosion and Corpl. Dunn was hit in the right knee and Pte. Payne was hit in the right hand. I was not hit. There had been a fire since early in the morning.

2. Statement made by 2789 Pte. C. Chaffey

At Ludansques, France, on January 12th 1918 at about 4.20 p.m., I was in the Billet used by the Battalion H'Qrs. runners. We had come in off the parade and were having tea. I took a piece of paper off ~~of~~ a pile of blankets on the floor and placed it on the fire. The paper quickly burnt up and I reached to the mantel-piece over the fire place and took down a pot of jam and laid it on the floor for the other men to use. I had turned round to go across to the next room (Orderly Room) to see to the fire there when I heard an explosion and heard Corpl Dunn and Pte. Payne sing out as they had both been hit. I am sure there was nothing in the paper I placed on the fire. It was a piece of wrapping paper from a parcel.

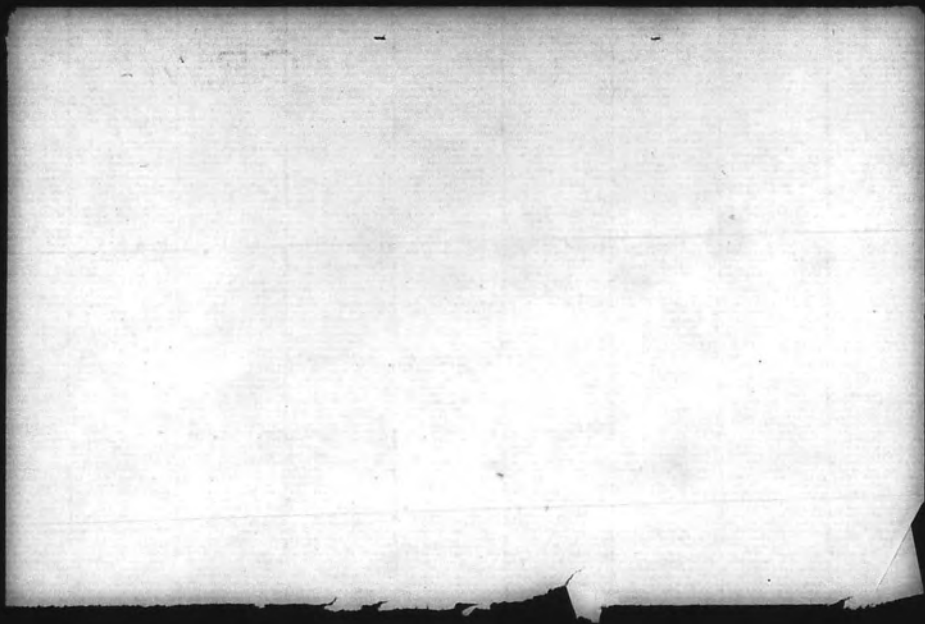

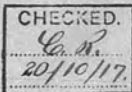

1. Statement made by 2827 Pte. A. Vatcher.

At Ludansques, France, on Jan'y 12- 1918, at about 4.20 p.m. I was in the Billet used by the Battn H.Qrs. runners. We had just come off the ceremonial parade and were sat around the fire place eating tea. I was sat in front of the fire place, Corpl. Dunn was sat on my right. Pte. Payn was on my left. Pte. Chaffey picked up a piece of heavy wrapping paper from the floor and placed it on the fire. Shortly after he placed it on the fire there was an explosion and Corpl. Dunn was hit in the right knee and Pte. Payn was hit in the right hand. I was not hit. There had been a fire since early in the morning.

I took a piece of paper off a pile of blankets on the floor and placed it on the fire. The paper quickly burnt up and I reached to the mantel-piece over the fire place and took down a pot of jam and laid it on the floor for the other men to use. I had turned round to go across to the next room (Orderly Room) to see to the fire there when I heard an explosion and heard Corpl. Dunn and Pte. Payn sing out as they had both been hit. I am sure there was nothing in the paper I placed on the fire. It was a piece of wrapping paper from a parcel.
