

Dear Madam,

In reply to your letter of the 13th instant, I desire to say that no further information as to the death of your brother, No. 2484, Private Clarence Pelley, who was killed in action on April 21st, has been received. You will readily understand that, with so very many casualties and fatalities to be dealt with by the army authorities in France, a considerable time must necessarily elapse before detailed information regarding each case, such as you naturally desire, can be forthcoming. Such particulars as may be obtainable are procured by the authorities of the Nfld. Pay and Record Office, London, and, together with official certificates of death, papers regarding the financial affairs of the deceased soldier, and any personal effects are transmitted to the authorities in Newfoundland who in turn arrange, as soon as possible, to communicate with the next of kin with respect thereto.

As such further information respecting your brother will, in due course, be received and transmitted to you

through the Department of Militia, I shall request




