REPORT OF INVESTIGATION BY C. O. INTO CHARGE AGAINST NO. 2436, Pte. D. Phillips FOR BEING ABSENT WITHOUT LEAVE WHEN WARNED TO PROCEED ON ACTIVE SERVICE.

2nd. Charge:- ESCAPING FROM GUARD WHILE UNDER SENTENCE OF DETENTION.

Evidence of No. 2897 ^{Actg.} / ~~Lt~~ Cpl. J. J. Strang.-

Sir: On July 18th. I was Actg. Sergt. of the Guard. I detailed 2 men of my Guard to bring the said Phillips to the lavatories. After prisoner was finished with the lavatories he evaded the Guard, jumped over the fence and escaped.
