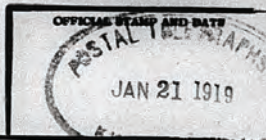

Dear Sir:-

Your letter of Feb. 3rd, concerning 4521 Pte. A.J. Pinksen, has been received.

In order to save time and expense I am endeavouring, if possible, to effect his discharge without bringing him into St John's for that purpose.

Your report stated that Pinksen was suffering from an ulcer of the knee on the site of an old scar, but I take it that this was not due to the effect of any military service on his part. If he is well in all other respects, would you kindly sign the form enclosed, for if he does suffer from any disability due to service with the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, then there will be no need to cause him to come to St John's to appear before the Standing Medical Board for examination in order to determine whether any pensionable liability exists.

I imagine that if he has been working in the lumber camps for some time recently, he must be a fit man. If you can get into touch with Pinksen, I should like you to find out, if possible, when he left Seal Cove, White Bay, to travel to Badger, for if he was fit to make the journey there a month or two ago, he must have been fit enough to come to St John's. The proper adjustment of his pay during his absence depends upon the time his fitness to report to St John's after his illness, and if he has absented himself without due cause then his pay is stopped for that period.

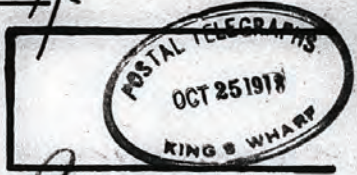
